

SKYLINE SOFTBALL LEAGUE FINES 2008

1. Any player who throws equipment or uses blatant profanity during a game will be ejected from the game, suspended for an additional game, and assessed a \$25.00 fine. The fine must be paid before the next game or the player will not play.
2. Failure to send a team representative to a League Meeting will result in a \$25.00 fine. The fine is payable at the next League Meeting. Failure to pay will result in team forfeiture.
3. Any team representative leaving a League Meeting early will result in a \$15.00 fine. The fine is payable at the next League Meeting.
4. Team forfeiture will result in a \$25.00 fine. The fine is payable before the next scheduled game. Failure to pay the fine will result in a game forfeiture. If a team forfeits 3 games in one season, it is automatically dropped from the League. In addition to the fine, the forfeiting team is responsible for paying \$45.00 to the other team for umpire fees.

5. Every player must be attired in the official team uniform. The following rules apply to players not wearing a team jersey:

1st player.....\$10.00 fine
2nd player.....\$15.00 additional fine
3rd player.....\$20.00 additional fine

MORE THAN 3 PLAYERS – TEAM FORFEIT

Official team uniform is:

- A. Same hat worn by everyone or no hat
- B. Same color/logo shirt

6. NO alcoholic beverages are allowed on any league field. If a player violates this rule, he will be ejected from the game and issued a \$50.00 fine. If a TEAM SPECTATOR violates this rule and is on the TEAM BENCH, the team will be issued a \$50.00 fine. Both instances will result in an AUTOMATIC team forfeit.
7. Any person caught driving on the fields will be fined \$100.00 and suspended for three games.
8. All League Officers & Team Captains will be responsible for CLEANING up team bench area. Failure to clean team bench area will result in a \$25.00 fine. Payable before next scheduled game. Failure to pay the fine will result in a game forfeiture.
9. Any player involved in any fighting confrontation will be fined \$50.00 and suspended for three games. A second confrontation will result in a suspension for the remainder of the season. The player will need a majority vote by the League Officers to be allowed to play in the League the following season.
10. Any player making any type of malicious contact with the umpire will be suspended for a minimum of the remainder of the year. The suspension may extend for a longer period.
11. There is a \$35.00 fine for any check returned unpaid. The League will also be reimbursed for any bank charges assessed by the check.
12. The winning team must call the League within 24 hours with the results of the game. Failure to notify the League will result in a \$10.00 fine. Please call (973) 476-7371 with game results.
